



TWERK VS BOUNCE BIKINI CONTEST

Official Rules, Entry Requirements & Judging Criteria

Event Date: Saturday, June 6, 2026

Entry Details

Prizes

- **1st Place: \$1,000**
- **2nd Place: \$500**
- **3rd Place: \$250**

Each Contestant will receive:

- **\$50 Gas Card** (issued after check-in)
- **Weekend Pass**

Eligibility

- Contestants must be **21 years of age or older**
- Valid government-issued ID **required at check-in**
- Contestants must register in advance (limited slots)

Contest Format

- Contestants will be assigned to either **Twerk** or **Bounce**
- Performance order will be determined by event staff
- Each contestant will receive **60–90 seconds** to perform

Official Contest Rules

1. Attire

- Bikini attire is required
- Pasties and thong-style bottoms are allowed if fully secured
- Contestants must remain appropriately covered at all times

2. Conduct

- No physical contact with judges
- No fighting or acts of violence
- Respect toward other contestants is required

3. Performance Guidelines

- Music will be provided by the event DJ
- No personal props that interfere with the performance area
- No climbing on speakers, rails, or stage equipment
- Contestants must remain within designated stage area

4. Safety & Compliance

- Any unsafe behavior may result in immediate disqualification
- Failure to follow staff instructions may result in removal
- Judges' decisions are final and not subject to appeal

Judging Criteria

Contestants will be judged on the following:

1. Dance Technique

- Control, rhythm, and execution of movements
- Clear demonstration of **Twerk** or **Bounce** style

2. Stage Presence

- Confidence
- Command of the stage
- Energy

3. Musicality

- Ability to move in sync with the beat
- Transitions and flow with the music

4. Creativity

- Originality of movements
- Unique style and performance personality

5. Crowd Engagement

- Audience reaction
- Ability to hype and connect with the crowd

6. Overall Performance

- Energy level
- Clean execution
- Memorability

Disqualification Conditions

A contestant may be disqualified for:

- Violating attire rules
- Unsafe or violent behavior
- Unsportsmanlike conduct
- Ignoring staff or judge instructions
- Appearing intoxicated or impaired

Check-in requirements

- Contestants must check in at the designated time
- ID verification required
- Wristbands must be worn at all times
- Gas cards distributed after successful check-in

- Participation implies agreement to all rules
- Contestants consent to photography and video recording
- The event reserves the right to remove any contestant at its discretion
